LIMITED SIRKETI (hereinafter referred to as "LIDOMA" or "we"), which was

established as a Limited Company in accordance with Turkish Laws and acts as Data

Controller, we are committed to respecting your personal data and other confidential

information and to taking all reasonable measures to ensure security and to provide the

security measures required by law.

For this reason, LIDOMA's Privacy Policy aims to provide the necessary information on

what purposes and how your data will be used by LIDOMA and with whom it may be

shared.

This Privacy Policy covers only the services provided through the lidoma.com (hereinafter

referred to as the "Site" or "Website") domain name. If your personal data is processed by

LIDOMA through our website, this data will be used in accordance with our Privacy Policy.

BY USING THE SITE, YOU AGREE TO THE PRIVACY POLICY AND APPLICABLE

TERMS OF USE.

We recommend that you view our Privacy Policy each time you visit our website. Because,

this Privacy Policy may be updated by **LIDOMA** from time to time for any reason. By using

our website, it will be assumed that you have read the latest version of our Privacy Policy

and accepted its amended terms. Changes to the Privacy Policy will take effect automatically

as soon as they are published on the Site. Each updated new version also applies to the

information already collected.

Any updates to the Privacy Policy will be published on the https://lidoma.com/ home page,

privacy statement page and other places deemed appropriate, and you will be informed about

how your personal information is collected, used or shared.

Processing of Your Data and Personal Data

Data is information about all numerical facts such as age, height, weight, and categorical facts such as brand, channel name, country, city, which have been collected and analyzed for the purpose of interpreting and presenting. The data also includes your personal data.

Personal data is any information relating to an identified or identifiable natural person, such as name, address, e-mail address, telephone number, date of birth, IP address. Your such data will be processed in full compliance with the Personal Data Protection Law, in addition to this Privacy Policy. In case of a conflict between this Privacy Policy and the relevant legislation, the legal legislation will prevail.

LIDOMA and our contracted service providers uses your personal data for purposes such as; to be able to research and answer your data, complaints, questions and opinions about your messages, to do the most appropriate work for your needs, to send our offers in line with your requests, to provide you with a better service, to facilitate the use of our website, to share advertising and marketing activities with you, to apply for your ideas, to offer a special campaign for you, developing products, projects or proposals.

Some sections of the site may require you to share certain personal data. In this context, you may need to provide your personal data only for the purpose of performing the service and activity in the relevant section. Sharing your personal data with us in such cases is entirely at your discretion, and if you choose not to share it, you may not be able to benefit from our relevant services or activities.

LIDOMA processes your personal data that you have voluntarily shared and forwarded, as well as your personal data in accordance with the general principles if there are processing conditions within the scope of legal legislation.

The information you are asked to provide is at a reasonable level and does not require you to disclose any further information. You may see a small red asterisk ("*") next to the information that we must provide in order to provide our services to you. Any information without this sign is optional information that you can present.

As **LIDOMA**, within the scope of your personal data:

When creating a User account, we store the following data: first and last name*, password*, e-mail address*, age*, country name, discord and instagram id. We need to collect an indication about your age to make sure that you comply with our minimum age requirements, or with specific age requirements applicable to selected features.

On our Site you may have the option to create a user account and subsequently log into it using a preexisting social media account, as displayed on our Website. If you choose this option, we will pull the following data from your social media profile to populate your user account: username. We use this information to scout for users that could potentially act as influencers for us. Furthermore, you have the option to link any of your accounts on supported social media with your user account on our website.

In the Communication section, we can process users' names, e-mail addresses and messages that users want to forward; to our employees, contracted service providers, authorized dealers, suppliers and affiliates who help us to continue our activities, authorized administrative institutions and other relevant persons and organizations in line with legal obligations.

We can also process scores, match history and scores, game statistics, and other aggregated or anonymous information, nicknames, as well as messages that users want to transmit; to our employees, contracted service providers, authorized affiliates who help us to continue our activities, authorized administrative institutions and other relevant persons and organizations in line with legal obligations.

We can process the name, e-mail address and personal data of people who want to work with us in the career section.

In accordance with Article 5 of the Personal Data Protection Law, personal data may be processed by **LIDOMA** without seeking the explicit consent of the data subject only in cases where one of the following conditions is met:

- **a)** It is expressly provided for by the laws.
- **b**) It is necessary for the protection of life or physical integrity of the person himself/herself or of any other person, who is unable to explain his/her consent due to the physical disability or whose consent is not deemed legally valid.

- c) Processing of personal data of the parties of a contract is necessary, provided that it is directly related to the establishment or performance of the contract.
- **d**) It is necessary for compliance with a legal obligation to which the data controller is subject.
- e) Personal data have been made public by the data subject himself/herself.
- f) Data processing is necessary for the establishment, exercise or protection of any right.
- **g)** Processing of data is necessary for the legitimate interests pursued by the data controller, provided that this processing shall not violate the fundamental rights and freedoms of the data subject.

Your sensitive personal data (persons' race, ethnic origin, political opinion, philosophical belief, religion, sect or other beliefs, disguise and dress, association, foundation or union membership, criminal conviction and security measures, biometric and genetic data) can only be processed in the cases stipulated by the laws. Adequate measures determined by the Board are taken while processing of special categories of personal data.

Personal data concerning health and sexual life may only be processed, without seeking explicit consent of the data subject, by the persons subject to secrecy obligation or competent public institutions and organizations, for the purposes of protection of public health, operation of preventive medicine, medical diagnosis, treatment and nursing services, planning and management of health-care services as well as their financing. Except in these cases, it will not be processed without your express consent.

The following principles will be complied by **LIDOMA** within the processing of personal data:

- a) Lawfulness and fairness
- **b**) Being accurate and kept up to date where necessary.
- c) Being processed for specified, explicit and legitimate purposes.
- d) Being relevant, limited and proportionate to the purposes for which they are processed.

e) Being stored for the period laid down by relevant legislation or the period required for the purpose for which the personal data are processed.

We have prepared separate clarification texts for the processing of your personal data by **LIDOMA**, for each area where your personal data is collected and also for the cookies used on the Site. You can access these clarification texts from the relevant sections, as well as via the **Communications Section Clarification Text**, **Career Section Clarification Text** and the **Clarification Text About Cookies** hyperlinks.

We may also collect your personal data in the following ways:

- The site server automatically collects information such as your internet protocol (IP) address, browser type and language, date and time of login to the application, to help us track user movements in the application and detect trends.
- One or more cookies (cookies) may be assigned (sent) to your device to facilitate your access to the Site and personalize your online experience. The Site uses "cookies" to carefully monitor certain information you enter when you visit or use the Site. "Cookies" are very small files on your computer for record-keeping purposes, which enable records to be kept and thus identified by the Site. The site also uses cookies to provide users with new content and information specific to their interests. Cookies are widely used on many websites and are not dependent on users' personal information. The Site may not work properly if your browser's settings are programmed to refuse all cookies. - LIDOMA or third parties such as LIDOMA's consultants who determine advertising and marketing strategies and performance assistants may use standard internet tools such as pixel tags (web beacons) that monitor your use of the Site, collect information that enables us to customize the services we offer and the advertisements we publish. Purpose of Processing Your Personal Data

Your personal data will also be processed in the presence of the conditions specified in the 2nd paragraph of the 5th article of the Personal Data Protection Law and the 3rd paragraph of the 6th article, in addition to the purposes such as providing the services provided in a complete and complete manner, improving them further, ensuring security and offering new services.

LIDOMA, processes your personal data:

- To be able to research and respond to your complaints, questions and opinions regarding your messages (such as helping you create an account, find a match, and resolve Player Support issues);
- To be able to prepare special sales offers and services for you in line with your requests, and to convey our offers;
- To fulfill our obligations regarding the performance of our services;
- To be able to make listing, reporting, verification, analysis and evaluations by creating a
 database, to produce statistical information and to share them with the experts of the
 business, provided that they comply with the confidentiality conditions;
- To be able to analyze how you use our website and other communication channels and to customize our communication channels to serve you better;
- To customize the advertisements and content you see on the Site and to facilitate the use of the Site;
- To be able to research and develop our projects and services and your personal choices regarding them;
- To detect and protect against abuse of the Site and fraudulent transactions;
- To be able to contact you through the communication channels you have shared with us, directly for the purpose of market research or through business partners from whom service is provided for this purpose;

- To provide you with better service by determining the most suitable projects and services for your needs;
- To be able to share advertising and marketing works with you, to apply for your ideas, to develop special campaigns, projects or offers for you;
- It functions to introduce our services or related products and projects to you, to maintain commercial communication about new projects, special offers and other topics or projects that we think you will find interesting.
- To make better the services accessible to you by accommodating specific needs you may
 have such as visual or hearing impairment by using text to voice or voice to text
 functionality. We only do this with your consent when you give us info about you for this
 specific purpose. You can withdraw that consent at any time;
- To administer surveys, contests, sweepstakes, and similar offerings (such as confirming your eligibility or sending you a prize if you win);
- We process your payment information for our legitimate interest within the scope of payment transactions in order to fully perform the services provided within the scope of our contractual relationship with you, to help you manage your accounts and, to comply with a legal obligation where relevant.

Data Integrity

LIDOMA attaches great importance to the fact that the collected data is accurate, complete, up-to-date and intended for use, and works within the framework of the principle of continuous improvement in this regard.

Sharing Your Personal Data

We are aware that it is a legal obligation that your personal data cannot be shared with third parties without consent and/or with the exceptions specified in the legislation on the protection of personal data.

LIDOMA reserves the right to share personal information of users compiled on the Site with third parties in cases where required by applicable legislation and laws, judicial decisions and proceedings,

summons and other legal proceedings, and also in order to prevent harm to its own interests, to protect the safety, rights and legitimate interests of itself and its employees, representatives and Site users.

LIDOMA can share your personal data with our employees, contracted service providers, 3rd party companies involved in the projects and services, associates who help us to continue our activities, authorized administrative organizations and other relevant persons in line with legal obligations and organizations.

These companies, with which we share your data, are liable to the current legislation, but must maintain the confidentiality of the information we have communicated to them. However, **LIDOMA** does not assume any responsibility for the unlawful acts of these third parties.

Our service providers, data analysts, advertising agencies, server providers, companies that provide data storage services, IT and virtual security companies, SMS or e-mail infrastructure services, customer services, are mandatory for us in any case to fulfill or increase the quality of these services and we work with these companies under full confidentiality agreements.

Commercial Transfer

The personal information of the Site users may be shared with the relevant third parties in case of transfer of assets and/or change of owners, such as possible merger, acquisition and/or acquisition of **LIDOMA**.

Data Transfer to Abroad

- **f**) Requesting the deletion or destruction of your personal data within the framework of the conditions stipulated in Article 7 of the Personal Data Protection Law,
- **g**) Requesting notification of the transactions made pursuant to subparagraphs (e) and (f) to the third parties to whom your personal data has been transferred,
- **h)** Objecting to the emergence of a result against you by analyzing your processed data exclusively through automated systems,
- i) If your personal data is damaged due to unlawful processing, you have the right to demand the compensation of the damage.

Options / Withdrawal

Users have the right to choose and/or change their preferences by following the methods below.

Security of Your Personal Data

LIDOMA attaches importance to protecting the privacy of your data. **LIDOMA** uses appropriate security systems in order to prevent the loss, alteration and use of the data under its control for different purposes, and our forms, which you send data to, also use Azure Cloud which is an encrypted

communication channel during transmission and encrypts information entries as an additional security application is protected by.

When such data reaches **LIDOMA**, these data are protected in accordance with our security and privacy standards. In order to benefit from Azure Cloud, your Internet browser must support Azure Cloud and the Azure Cloud options in your browser must be active.

We also take all administrative measures that we believe are necessary to protect and preserve your personal data. Only authorized employees are allowed to access your personal data to perform their duties related to our services. In this context, our personnel also receive the necessary training and start working after the necessary information process.

However, as in every online data transfer, due to the nature of the information technology sector; **LIDOMA**'s establishment of a level of security that meets the standards will not be able to prevent unauthorized access.
